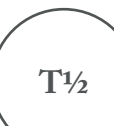

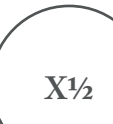

You will need to find a way of discreetly getting your hands on one of your partners rings. Be certain that it will fit their ring finger. Engagement rings are usually worn on the left hand.

Place the ring over the circles to the right, so the inside edge of the ring matches the circle nearest in size. This measurement will reveal the diameter of the ring. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size. There are also half and quarter sizes available, but enquire first.
